

Safety Card: Zoom



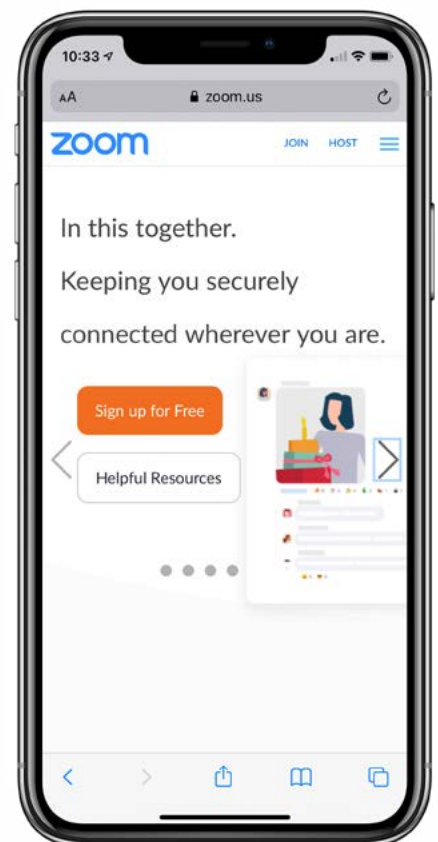

Lock a meeting

Lock a meeting using these simple instructions;

- > In the meeting tap on ●●● in the bottom right corner.
- > Tap on **Security**.
- > Swipe the tab beside Lock Meeting to the right.
- > The meeting is now locked.



Report

Report a participant using these simple instructions;

- > Select **Participants** in the tool bar.
- > Select the user you wish to report.
- > Tap on **Remove**.
- > Tap **Remove and Report** and then select a reason.
- > The participant is now reported.
