



Horizon Worlds is Meta's virtual reality social space and an example of the concept of 'metaverse'. It contains an ever-expanding catalogue of virtual experiences designed and built by the users.

Stay safer on Horizon Worlds using the instructions below on **Personal Boundary settings, reporting and blocking**.



The **Personal Boundary** feature adds a radius of personal space to your avatar.

Turning **Personal Boundary** on:

1. Go to your **Settings**.
2. Select **Safety**.
3. Select from the dropdown beside '**Personal Boundary**'.
4. You can select from the three options '**Non-Friends, On for Everyone and Off**'.



The **Safe Zone** is a personal, protective bubble users can activate where no one can touch or talk to you. It also allows users to report, block and mute other users.

The **Blocking** users using your **Safe Zone**:

1. Select the **Shield** icon on your wristband.
2. Select **View Nearby People**.
3. Find the user's card you want to block.
4. Select **Block** and then confirm.

**Blocking** someone in **Horizon Worlds** will also block their **Oculus** account.



**Reporting** users using your **Safe Zone**:

1. Select the **Shield** icon on your wristband.
2. Select **View Nearby People**.
3. Find the user's card you want to report.
4. Select **Report** and then Submit.

Once you submit your report, a short recording of the last few minutes of your activity on **Horizon Worlds** is sent to the **Meta** moderators.
